

**American Team Wins Samsung Super League in Aachen, Germany**

It was the first time the Americans had won in Aachen since 1987. The result also puts the U.S. in first place in the league standings with only one event left—Barcelona, September 15 – 18.

Team member McLain Ward shocked the world when it was discovered that he rode one of only two double-clear rounds at the event while enduring a broken collar bone. And it was the American women who had turned heads at an earlier Samsung Super League event, in Hickstead in the UK, when Laura Kraut and Kimberly Prince took first and second in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup—the grand prix for lady riders.
